NZIBO registration is now open at <https://nzibo.org/registration/>

Registration closes on Sunday 11th of August and no late registrations can be accepted.

The two-hour exam will be held online, on Wednesday 21st of August.

On the NZIBO webpage, we have uploaded the 2021 and 2022 entrance exams.

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Registration is FREE for Māori and Pasifika students in; Pūhoro STEMM Academy, Te Whare Wānanga, Whakapiki Ake, and FOU Health Science Academy.

Students who were in the NZIBO tutorial programme in previous years have automatic entry into the 2024/2025 tutorial programme but they must register and pay the registration fee.
