What do you need: Gloves

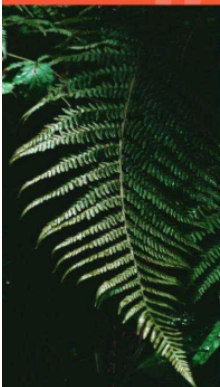
Additional information: Please come with a guardian if you are not 16.
