# Year 11 Rangitoto Diploma

- An alternative to the optional Level 1 NCEA qualification.
- Diploma offers rigour through a Knowledge rich curriculum
- Academic and social success
- Effectively prepare for Level 2 NCEA or IB

# Why not Level 1 NCEA?

- New NCEA Levels 2&3 not yet developed
- The Rangitoto Diploma has more academic rigour

# What do students study?

- Internal and External assessment - fit for purpose
- End of year exams/portfolio submission

# How does the Diploma align with Level 2&3 NCEA?

- **60 Credits:** For both the Diploma and NCEA at Levels 1-3
- **Numeracy & Literacy:** For both, students must have gained the 20 credits numeracy/literacy.
- **Endorsement:** (NCEA/Diploma)
  - Achieved = White
  - Merit = Red
  - Excellence = Blue
